



Your child will need the supplies listed below. Please bring the supplies with you to *Meet The Teacher Night* or send in with your child on the first day of school.

**\*\*\*\*During the first few days of school, please send in a note indicating how your child will be coming home from school (bus, after school care, parent pick-up, etc.)**

- Pencils (sharpened) . three sharpened pencils ready for each day.
- Ruler (marked in inch and metric units)
- Crayons or Colored Pencils or Markers
- Scissors
- Glue or Glue Stick
- Highlighters (of various colors) . preferred, but optional
- Gallon-size Zip-lock Bag or a Pencil Box or Pouch for supplies
- 2 Packages of Loose Leaf Paper
- 3 x 5 Index Cards
- A Five-Section Notebook (for subjects other than LA)
- A Three-Section Notebook (for Language Arts)
- Six Color-Coded Folders (one for each major subject)
- 2 Composition Books
- An Organization System - Binders are optional. You may want a binder, or an accordion folder, but you must have an organization system that **works** for you.
- A designated way to take papers home and bring them back. This may be a %Take Home+folder or a section of your binder or accordion folder.
- Book Covers for each textbook (5). Books must be covered, but you do not need to purchase covers. You may cut and fold sturdy brown paper grocery bags. (Time will be provided in class to cover books and students can take them home to cover, too.)

**Suggestion:** Purchase a second five-section notebook and extra folders now when they are less expensive so you will have enough for later in the year.

**Music:**

- 1 Folder with 3 Fasteners
- 1 Soprano Recorder (If you do not have a recorder, order forms will be available in music class)

**Health:**

- 1 Pocket Folder and a Notebook

**Spanish:**

- 1-1" Binder (with front and back pockets)
- 5 Tab Dividers for the Binder
- 50 Sheets of Loose-Leaf Paper to go in the Binder
